



Modern Slavery and Human Trafficking Statement

Industrial water Jetting Systems Ltd, (The Company) with a turnover of under £36m strictly speaking are outside of the threshold that requires us to write this statement, but to write it shows how seriously the company takes this issue. The company has a zero tolerance to slavery and human trafficking, and we expect our supply chain to have similar values.

Industrial Water Jetting Systems Ltd is a company supplying drain and sewer cleaning services, liquid waste tankering Services, drain and sewer CCTV surveying and rehabilitation services to many waste water utility companies, private companies outside of the waste water industry as well as to industry at large.

Our Directors have been briefed on the subject and with this statement and fully back the issue of this statement. The Directors will expect staff to report concerns within the supply chain, or locally, and Managers will be expected to act upon those reports.

The company does not utilise huge amounts of product, being largely a service industry, but from April 2017, the company supply chain questionnaires will seek assurance from our suppliers, and sub-contractors, to show their support for The Company position on the problems found with Slavery and human trafficking in many parts of the world.

To ensure awareness The Company will put together a briefing to be issued to all staff telling of the problems that are to be found and how to report such issues.
